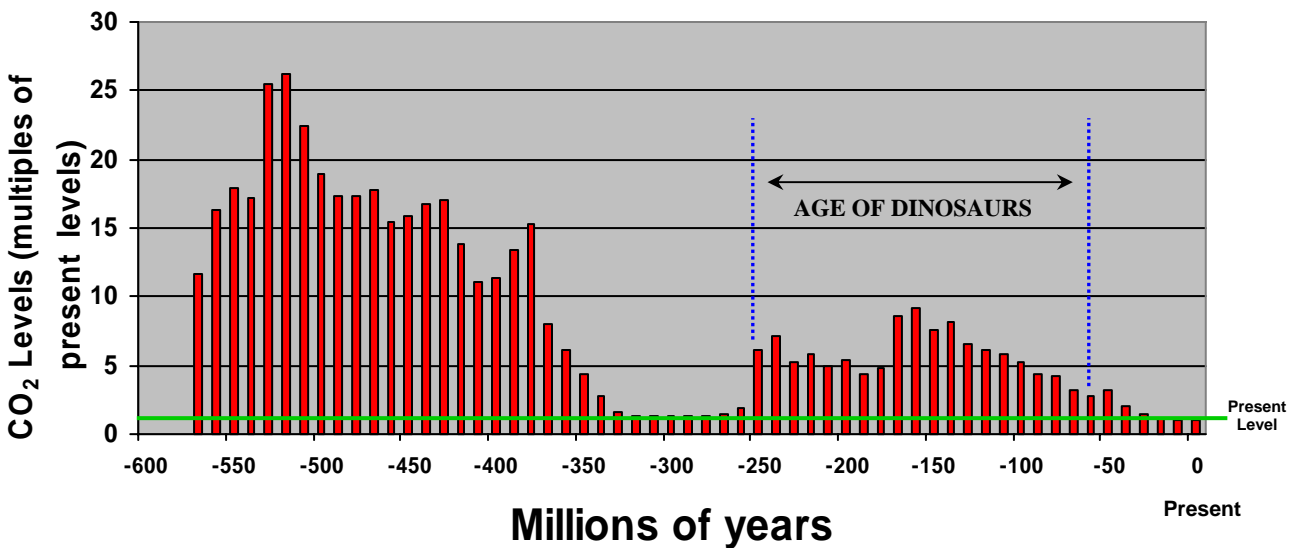


Historic Atmospheric CO₂
